



Cockscomb Chief Red Celosia

Nothing else in the garden looks like crested Cockscomb, bred especially for cut flowers. The 5-inch heads arise in scarlet, clear rose, and 4 bicolors: red-and-gold, carmine-rose, carmine-red, and golden-yellow. Each densely-packed flowerhead appears on its own sturdy stem, well above the thick, long foliage of fresh green on these 2 1/2-foot plants. Unforgettable for garden or vase!

Celosia is colorful over a very long summer season, and the dried flowerheads are magnificent in arrangements. It is unforgettable in the border or in a mass planting, where its utterly unique shape is eye-catching, and its dense flowerheads seem to glow with strong color.
