Last twice as long as Roses in the vase!

Heidi's unique habit makes it the hands-down favorite Lisianthus for the vase. Instead of bearing its big, 3 1/2-inch, Rose-like blooms along stems that open from the bottom up, it sports them all at the top of the plant, in great sprays of rich color! This mix gives you all the Heidi hybrids you love, including several picotee varieties and the unusual salmon and yellow hues!

As elegant as Roses and twice as long-lasting for the vase, this hybrid is very vigorous, early to bloom, and uniform. The plants grow 16 to 18 inches tall, with long thin stems and fat heart-shaped leaves.

Lisianthus is one of Nature's great imitators--its gorgeous blooms look like Roses in bud, open to Tulip form, and at maturity resemble Poppies! Pest-free and very long-blooming through midsummer heat, drought, or rain, the flowers last 2 weeks or more when cut for the vase!
