Huge 8-inch blooms!

This light-toned dwarf Sunflower bears plenty of enormous blooms on each bushy, very dense 24- to 30-inch plant! The blooms have chartreuse centers, a ring of light brown, and masses of frilly yellow petals--cheery and so striking in the garden or vase! The plants were originally developed for containers, but have proved fabulous border performers as well. The blooms keep coming over a very long season, bringing in the butterflies and songbirds with them!

Sunflowers are the kings of the natural sunny summer garden, attracting butterflies and birds. They're wonderfully easy to grow--just direct-sow the large seeds after all danger of frost. Not picky about soil type, they need direct sun.
