



Hypericum calycinum

Common Name: St. John's Wort

Bloom Time: May-June

Height: 6-12"

Exposure: Sun to Part Shade

General Information:

This beautiful and versatile plant can be used as a flowering shrub or ground cover. Works in rock gardens and is good for stabilizing embankments or hillsides. Good for planting under trees where it competes well with shallow tree roots. Tolerates wide range of soils. Less floriferous in part shade. Plant 18" apart for use as a ground cover.
